## **Tournament Rules:**

- Players will start with 10,000 in tournament chips.
- On-Site registration and re-entry available until the start of Level 9. 2.
- Levels will last 15 minutes each. This is a one-day tournament. 3.
- 4. This tournament will be played 9 handed.
- Redraw at Final Table of 9 players.
- Players may forfeit their stack at the end of registration to re-enter. 6.
- 7. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The big blind is paid before the ante.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
- 10. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 11. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable. No Refunds.
- \$280 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$20 is a registration fee of which \$10 will go towards staffing.
- 14. The player with the most tournament chips at the end of registration will receive \$1,000 which comes from the prize pool.
- 15. All entry fee monies above what is needed to fund the guaranteed cash prizes will go to the charity.
