Tournament Rules:

- 1. Players will start with 125,000 in tournament chips.
- 2. Levels will last 40 minutes each. This is a one-day tournament.
- 3. On-site registration and unlimited re-entries available until the start of level 7. Players may forfeit their tournament chips at the end of registration to re-enter.
- 4. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play. Alternates and late entries purchased after the start of the tournament will have no obligation and will not be live until the player has been dealt in. Alternates and late entries may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates not sat during the registration period will be entitled to a refund.
- 5. This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The ante is paid before the big blind.
- 6. The big blind ante will not be calculated in the opening PLO preflop raise.
- 7. Management reserves the right to alter, change or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on websites or printed materials and players will have no claim in these matters.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties
 determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament players' responsibility to bring to
 management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 9. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
- Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 11. This tournament will be played 8 handed.
- 12. Redraw at 16 and 9 players or at tournament director's discretion.
- 13. Shot clocks will be used in this event. Each entry will be given (6) time chips at the start of the event. The final (9) players will be issued an additional (6) more time chips each.
- 14. \$9,500 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$500 is the registration fee of which \$150 will go towards staffing.
- 15. This tournament uses Pay Chart Eight Handed.
